Update on the construction work

- Preparations for the main works have started.
- The main works will start in July 2016.
- The replacement of the hoarding along Carnwath Road will start from 9 May 2016 and take approximately nine weeks to complete.
- The new hoarding along the boundary of our site on Carnwath Road will be 3.6m in height. The new hoarding at the west end of the site, the section facing your estate, will be 5m high, to try to provide a noise and dust barrier for the homes next to the site.
- Tideway has started consultation on the design on the new hoarding, deadline for your views will be on 13 May.

Construction noise—The noise presentation by Tideway at the CLWG meeting in March indicated

that noise levels inside Arhag flats would remain within acceptable limits. This was confirmed by a noise expert who is currently representing Arhag and Network Stadium.

Updates from the CLWG

The Community Liaison Working Group has now had 3 meetings and has established a structure of working. The main group will meet every month. There are also 4 sub groups:

- **Health**, including noise and air pollution and the effects on physical and mental health of local people
- **Traffic**, including both road and river traffic
- **Property**, studying the impact on buildings within 200m of the site
- **Legacy**, which deals with the offer from Thames Tideway to improve the local area as thanks to the community
