

Parsons North Development



Thank you for your continued patience with the start of planned works next to Parsons House.

We wanted to write to update you about the start of physical works on site. The site perimeter and hoarding has now been set up around the basement car park next to Parsons House as the construction works have now commenced. The first stage of these works is the demolition of the ground floor concrete over the basement car park which will involve some noisy work. We will try and limit the impact as much as possible.

You may also notice some small changes around the block. The recycling centre needed to be moved to enable the site to be set up. You can find the recycling centre on Hall Place near Heywood House. Please ensure that you only use this for recycling as there are no black bins for general rubbish. A two storey site office was installed in February, which is where the project team is based.

Public Liaison Officer, Curtis Donovan, has been on site from early February. He has been in the area recently carrying out surveys with residents from Parsons House to understand how you would like us to engage with you for the duration of the project. The survey aims to understand:

- The best way to communicate with you
- If you have any specific concerns that you may have regarding the construction works
- If you have a gas supply to your home
- If you are interested in any of our employment opportunities

The surveys will continue for the next few weeks so please look out for Curtis and his team.
