After the Ballot – What Happens Now?

In July 2024, the Canning Town Ballot was held. 70% of residents who participated voted in favour of the regeneration plans for Canning Town.

All residents were sent the Landlord Offer document, which sets out the council's commitments to all residents on the estate and outlines the plans for the future of the estate, including what the new buildings and communal spaces are going to look like. You will have probably seen that the Vincent Street development is progressing. The buildings will be ready for people to move into in 2027. This means many of you will be moving into this new building to enable the plans to progress to the next phase by emptying some of the old homes.

Newham Council has already started to speak with many of you about your housing needs and preferences. We will be supporting Newham Council to make sure that they speak to as many of you as possible to understand your preferences for when you move. If you have yet to speak with the council but would like to do so, please email regeneration@newham.gov.uk and someone will contact you.

The Architects will start to further progress the designs for later phases in the new year. They will be hoping to get input from residents to help them do this. Keep an eye out for more details in 2025.
